The Wines...

Whites

Italy - Principato **Pinot Grigio** 75cl - 12% ABV - **8.75**

Shows delicate, floral and fruity aromas with a hint of stone fruit. The palate is crisp with citrus characters and a limey and lightly spicy finish

South Africa - Cape Heights **Chardonnay** 75cl - 13% ABV - **8.75**

Fresh, tangy varietal fruit with perfumed jasmine notes and white stone fruit flavours. There is real breadth and character on the palate and a refreshing finish

New Zealand - Cloud Factory **Sauvignon Blanc** 75cl - 13.5% ABV - **10**

Perfumed with nettle ripe tropical fruits which are also evident on the palate along with limey flavours and a rich minerality - classic Marlborough Sauvignon

Rosé

Italy - Ancora **Pinot Grigio Rosé** 75cl - 12% ABV - **8.75**

A dry, fresh and fruity rosé with delicate aromas of red berries. Crisp and lively on the palate with good intensity of ripe berry and red cherry fruit

USA California - The Big Top **White Zinfandel Rosé** 75cl - 11% ABV - **8.75**

Luscious strawberry ice cream on the nose supported by a bright, berry fruited palate and an off dry finish

Reds

Australia - Soldiers Block **Shiraz** 75cl - 14% ABV - **8.75**

A big punch of crushed cranberry and blackcurrant on the nose with a good dash of spice. The palate is medium to full bodied

Chile - Sierra Grande **Merlot** 75cl - 13% ABV - **8.75**

Ripe plum and berry fruit aromas. Warm and supple on the palate with rich fruit and soft tannins

France - Bellefontaine **Cabernet Sauvignon** 75cl - 14% ABV - **8.75**

Quite ripe blackcurrant and wild berry fruits on the nose with a hint of grassy herbs, medium to full-bodied black fruits balanced by dry-ish grip and length offered by underlying but not overpowering tannins

Australia - The Listening Station **Malbec** 75cl - 14% ABV - **9.25**

Intense ripe blackcurrant aromas with aromatic spices of clove and vanilla. Black current and black berry fruit flavours are backed by fine, well-structured tannins. The ripe fruit is sumptuous and lingers on the palate

Spain - Vega Del Rayo **Rioja** 75cl - 13% ABV - **11**

It has a nose of plums and wild blackberry with hints of citrus fruits and raisins. The sweet vanilla and brown spices from ageing in wood, are well balanced

White

Italy - Sartori Prosecco - 11% ABV

Delicately fruity aroma with hints of wild apple and acacia flowers that give feelings of freshness. Delicious flavours of apples and ripe pears cooked, nice and elegant minerality notes and final round

The FAQs...

How many pints In a litre?

1 litre is 1.76 pints, so, 2 litres = 3.5 pints, 2.5 litres = 4.4 pints, 5 litres = 8.8 pints ,10 litres = 17.6 pints, and 20 litres = 35 pints

What Is the difference between casked and kegged?

Casked beer is Britain's finest ever invention, better than penicillin, the Internet, the corkscrew, Marmite and Viagra put together (don't try that at home!). Casked beer undergoes a secondary fermentation inside the cask making a "live" beer. This needs to be managed in the cellar very carefully to maintain quality. Casked beer tends to be less fizzy and served at 11-13°C through a hand pulled hydraulic pump.

Kegged beer is brewed in exactly the same way as casked beer however the process is complete when the beer is packaged in an airtight keg. This along with the carbon dioxide and nitrogen delivery system means kegged beer has a longer shelf life than casked beer and is much easier to keep. Kegged beer is usually fizzier and served at a cooler temperature, generally between 2-8°C through a beer font.

How do I pay for my take-away?

Pay securely using Round App, or, fill in the online order form and we will send a link for a secure card payment website to your preferred contact details. (Hogs Head Brew House do not hold or pass on any personal details to third parties)

What am I paying a deposit on?

All ale/lager containers have a deposit of 2.50. This is included in the prices shown.

How do I get my deposit back for my empty bottle?

Bottles can be returned when we are open for take-aways Friday and Saturday 4-6pm. Deposits will be returned for containers returned in good, clean condition.

Is there an option on Round App to order drinks without the deposit charge if I am returning a bottle?

No. All the ales and lagers include a deposit charge which will be refunded when the container is returned

How long will the beer keep?

The beers will keep for the following lengths of time;

1 and 2 litre bottles - once opened keep chilled and drink within 2 days, will keep for 30 days unopened

2.5 litre jugs - keep chilled and drink within 2 days

5, 10 and 20 litre bags - keep cool and drink within 7 days

What happens if I can't collect?

If your situation changes after you have placed an order ie/ you have to self-isolate, please get in touch and we will do our best to deliver (no promises!)
